



A **Be in the here and now**
Black Sun by Pedro Reyes

Alluding to the function of a sundial, the shadow from the needle between the fingers draws a line on the palm of a hand, silently marking the passing of time. Just as every human hand is different, every sundial displays a unique lifeline drawn by the sun. *What brought you here, now?*

B **Explore the self**

The wings embody the primordial dream of flight, the essential human desire for freedom. Conjuring ancient monoliths, the sculpture incorporates symbols from the artists' native India along with Hawaiian maile leaves symbolizing peace. *What does freedom look like to you?*

Consider all the living beings around you; each one unique and on their own path. Listen to the birds, the insects, the wind in the trees. Can you hear the whispers of the spirits? *Imagine yourself in the life of another.*
